LINGUISTIC PATHS IN PRIMARY

In *maternelle*, the students are taught in a way that allows them to master the French language and integrate English at the same time. This teaching integrates specific pedagogical objectives and approaches aimed at mastering the child's primary language and French. At the end of *maternelle*, the children continue their studies in an international section, which offers a very high quality pedagogical and didactic framework for integrated language and cultural education.

LINGUISTIC PATHS IN HIGH SCHOOL

When arriving at the college, students are provided with instruction in English and begin learning Spanish for 2.5 hours per week, with additional instruction depending on the course chosen by the student. By choosing the international section in 3ème, students can take the International Option of the National Diploma of the Brevet (DNBi).

At the lycée, students can choose to take one of the following courses: the PARLE path, the Arabic / Chinese section or the International Section (SI). The SI allows students to take the International Option of the Baccalaureate (OIB) in the Baccalaureate exams.
